Bios

Lynne Sachs (1961) is an experimental filmmaker and poet living in Brooklyn, New York. Her films embrace archives, diaries, letters, poetry and music to take us on a critical journey through reality and memory. Working from a feminist perspective, Lynne investigates the connections between the body, the camera, and the materiality of film itself. Retrospectives of her 50 feature-length and short films have been presented in Argentina, China, Ecuador, Germany, Mexico, the UK and the US.

Luiza Parvu is a Romanian-born filmmaker, visual artist and educator based in Tempe, AZ. She is a member of the European Film Academy. She holds an MFA in Film Production from NYU Tisch. Her work has been recognized in festivals from Karlovy Vary, Sundance, BFI London, True/False to Transilvania or Tribeca. Her work spans formats in fiction and documentary film, as well as in multimedia installation. It explores identity, memory, intersectionality and transformation, with a focus on labor migration and environmental crisis. She is an Assistant Professor

at Arizona State University and a programmer for the Mimesis Documentary Festival.
